

CASE STUDY:

INNOVATIVE WAYS OF INCREASING PARTICIPATION AND MEMBERSHIP

LEAMINGTON SQUASH CLUB



OVERVIEW

Leamington Squash Club identified that in order to attract new members and retain existing members, an internal focus on providing a high-quality environment and offering enjoyable experiences to foster membership satisfaction is the key. To achieve this the club needed to understand the thoughts of their members and provided them with an opportunity to provide feedback how the club could meet their expectations. A survey was administered through Survey Monkey and included questions which ranged from juniors, coaching, the facility, programmes and activities to the people themselves. As a result the club have already actioned the small suggestions and now look to use the feedback to plan longer-term.

CHALLENGES

Member Engagement

Keeping members engaged so that they feel valued and giving them the opportunity to discuss how they feel.

Time

The majority of members are busy 'with many balls in the air' and struggle to justify spending time on court when other life concerns take priority, especially when distance is an issue.

Survey response

Helping members see the value in doing the survey and offering honest feedback to improve the club.

SOLUTIONS

Survey

In order to better understand what the member experience is like, Leamington Squash Club conducted a survey covering all aspects of club life

Online

The survey link was sent via email and conducted online so members could complete it in their own time and in the comfort of their homes.

Incentive

Two small prize packs (squash equipment) were offered for those who provided personal details at the end of the survey.

RESULTS



Of 5 short-term projects already actioned.

CONCLUSION

The Learnington Squash Club are looking at membership differently and have committed to generating a great member experience at their club rather than as a number. Opening the discussion with their members through a club survey was just the beginning. There has been some very useful information gathered from member suggestions which will now be incorporated into the club's 2, 5 and 10-year plans.

Club President Anthony Blackmoore said they "should have done this earlier. Making the survey anonymous encouraged members to give truthful comments. It has provided the club with such invaluable feedback and has also created a greater awareness of what happens behind the scenes. We will look to do this every couple of years to check where things are to keep our members involved and enjoying their experiences at our club."

Anthony suggests that "we didn't get great buy-in from juniors. If we did it again, we would write a letter and give to juniors to take home so they could give it to their parents and complete the questions relevant to them."
