



Summary of Requirements to achieve NZ District Referee

Pre-requisites

- Have natural or corrected 20-20 vision and good hearing; and
- Sign and abide by the Squash New Zealand Code of Ethics for Referees

Theory Requirements

- Pass the Squash Australia Rules exam with 90% required in Part A and 85% in Part B – Closed Book

Practical Requirements – Activity and Assessment

- Activity of 6 matches up to and including at least 4 on Men's B Grade per year
- 1 passing assessment on marking on Mens B grade or above – only for initial accreditation, not required for renewing
- At least 2 assessments
- At least one passing assessment on a Regular match at Men's B1 Grade or higher
- Passes must exceed not to standard assessments in number
- At least 9 of the 12 boxes on the assessment sheet for competencies 1 (injury rule) and 3-13 must be ticked over all assessments, and
- The overall error rate in all assessments, including invalid assessments, is not more than 15%
