Team Composition GC2020

A team of 18 players consisting of the following players will be selected:

- 2 x U/13 Girls & 2 x U/13 Boys
- 2 x U/15 Girls & 2 x U/15 Boys
- 2 x U/17 Girls & 2 x U/17 Boys
- 2 x U/19 Girls & 4 x U/19 Boys (world championship year)*
 - The age cut-off date is the 15th April 2020
 - The team will be led by 2 coaches and 2/3 managers.
 - The higher number of boys is to provide preparation for the 2020 World Junior Boy's Team Championships to allow for increased international exposure and preparation.

- The weighting of the criteria will be at the discretion of the selectors
- The team will be selected and announced at the end of February 2020

Team Composition GC2020

Boys Individuals & Team Event

The team will comprise:

- Five players selected according to the selection criteria being the team of 4 and a travelling reserve.
- A sixth player may be added to the team – the selectors have the discretion to nominate the sixth in results order, or a development player.

Girls Individuals

The individuals will comprise:

- Three players selected according to the selection criteria
- A further three players may be added as development players for the 2021 World Junior Championships

FAQ GC2020

Why are the events all in Auckland?

- This series of tournaments is in the preferred window for earlier team selection
- One location means reduced travel costs and the option to stay on location over the series
- The time of year means the temperature will be similar to GC conditions
- Players will be able to gain PSA points in all events
