What Happens Next?

During Alert level 2:

All SNZ events will still remain suspended but under review

SNZ to work with Districts to assess what type of events/competitions can go ahead as we move through level 2.

Follow our level guidelines to see if your event can go ahead

NZ Shifts to Alert level 1:

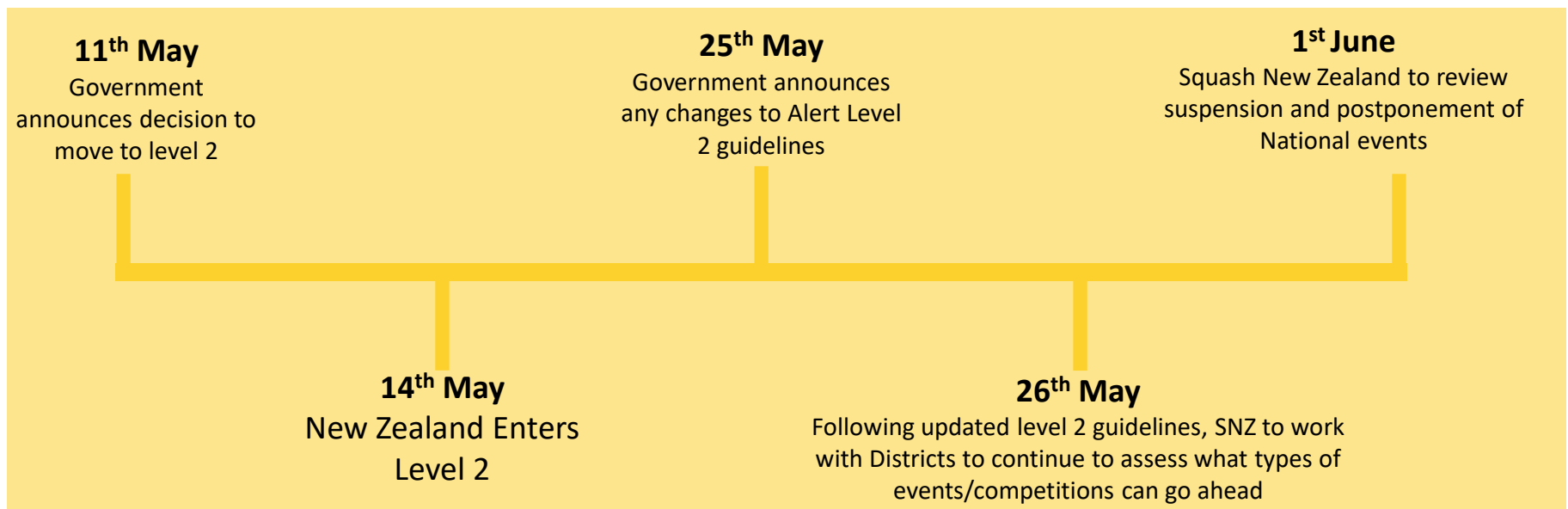
Squash NZ Events and Competitions are risk assessed and reviewed to determine if they will proceed. Decisions to be made in consultation with Host Clubs and Districts.
