EIGHT-STRONG NZ TEAM NAMED FOR GLASGOW COMM GAMES

The New Zealand Olympic Committee selection panel has confirmed an eight strong squash team for the Commonwealth Games in Glasgow from July 23 - August 3.

The team is headlined by world number four Joelle King. King was the star of the 2010 Delhi campaign, picking up a gold medal in the women's doubles with the now retired Jaclyn Hawkes, and a silver medal in the mixed doubles with Martin Knight. King was later accorded the honour of carrying the New Zealand flag at the closing ceremony.


